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$$\frac{e^{i\omega t}}{2+3i}$$

$$= \frac{2-3i}{13} (\cos \omega t + i \sin \omega t)$$

Real Part:  $\frac{2}{13} \cos \omega t + \frac{3}{13} \sin \omega t$  Rectangular form

$$= \sqrt{\left(\frac{2}{13}\right)^2 + \left(\frac{3}{13}\right)^2} \cos \left(\omega t - \tan^{-1} \frac{3}{2}\right)$$


$$= \frac{\sqrt{13}}{13} \cos \left(\omega t - \tan^{-1} \frac{3}{2}\right)$$
